Paul and I asked our supporters to continue to support us through the end of 2009. We are very grateful that enough support continued to allow us time for at least one of us to find a job. Paul is working for the Housing Authority of Crescent City. I continue to substitute teach and have started African Fabrications. I am selling via the Internet African fabric, embroidered items, and beaded jewelry imported from South Africa. I will sell quilts and other items that I make. The website will be launched soon. This week we have moved into a beautiful house with an ocean view that we are housesitting until it sells. It is taking some adjustment getting used to so much room after living in a fifth wheel trailer for nine months!

This is the last Reyman E mail Report. Starting next month it will be only news about Khayelihle Children's Village. We are continuing Reyman Africa Mission because support for Khayelihle Children's Village is received through Reyman Africa Mission. We ended 2009 with a balance of funds that we will use in the future for a return mission trip that could be next year depending on work schedules. A financial report for 2009 will be available in a few weeks.

We are very happy to have made it to this year and we give praise to the Almighty who saw us through. Compliments of the new season to you all!

The number of our children is still 89. Thank you all for making it possible for the children to celebrate Christmas in a special way with special eats and clothing.

The children have started back to school. This year we have ten children at preschool, 52 at primary, of these, 6 are in grade one. Eighteen are at high schools and two at College. A senior boy and senior girl will be joining others at College to do courses in motor mechanics and hairdressing, respectively. We are very proud to announce that Nyarai Moyo graduated last year in December and holds a certificate of an Honours Degree in Psychology. She is currently hunting for a job and at the same is sponsorship for her master's Degree.

Four of our 105 children in our Community Orphan Care Programme (COCP), who are doing tertiary education, will be sitting for their final examinations this month end. Please pray for them so that they remember all they have been taught last year.

The children continue to worship at the KCV Church of Christ. The staff and neighbours have also been loyal to the Church. Our youth attended a conference during the month of December. Their theme was "Building a better foundation for a future generation". We thank God for His love and service.

The rains this year have been erratic. However, our maize crop is just surviving, hence we will have a low yield.

We have constructed a second reservoir that is yet to be equipped to enable it to pump water into the houses.

The Zimbabwe house is now complete. However, it has no furniture and curtains. As soon as it is furnished, more children will be taken in.
